 Scope: Lath, stucco, specialty finishes, EIFS and EIFS shapes.

BakerTriangle used ParexLahabra materials to install over one mile of EPS Shapes, 65,000 square feet of three coat stucco, 25,000 square feet of EIFS and over 12,000 square feet of direct applied ceilings and soffits. Each system with it's own specialty finish, antiquing gels and waterproofing systems. A total of 9 different textures, 15 different colors, 12 antiquing gels with 4 or 5 shades each for a total of over 60 color variations.

Only a site visit would help one appreciate the intricate details that went into this beautiful retail center. The EIFS shapes were coated with two coats of the Stucco Deraffinato, giving them an amazing stone-like appearance. After sanding the stucco Teifs antiquing gels were used to achieve the Tuscan look that the architect was looking for. The accelerated schedule of this project was accomplished by 50 hour work weeks and talented craftsmen.
