River Crest is Fort Worth’s oldest and most storied country club. Golf greats of the past and present have walked through the halls and dining rooms of River Crest. Built in 1911, it was due for a major renovation and expansion.

And BakerTriangle was honored to be called in to work on intricate ceiling designs that included a vaulted fabric ceiling (by AEC) and a fabric ceiling tile. Hunter Douglas Techstyle panels were used throughout the facility in ceiling details to simulate wood panels and art deco ceilings. These suspended ceilings are available for standard lay-in installation or with concealed clips for convenient swing-down access. New systems and materials allowed for affordable and quick installation.
